Maine's Changing Population

- ★ Maine is now the oldest state in the union with a median age of 41.2.¹ That is nearly a full five years above the US average of 36.4.
- ★ From **2005 to 2015**, the total population is expected to increase by 94,000 or 7.1%. The population **age 65+** is expected to **increase by 56,000 or 29.1%**
- ★ From **2005 to 2025**, the total population is expected to increase by 137,000 or 10.4%. The population **age 65+** is expected to **increase by 151,700 or 78.7%**
