Blood Pressure Review and Update Program: What Practices are Saying

The MaineHealth Cardiovascular Health Program created the Blood Pressure Review and Update in-service and upcoming e-learn in response to requests from MMC PHO practices for a practical update around accurate blood pressure measurement and guidelines. So far, nearly 10 practices have taken advantage of the program with great satisfaction.

- Over 95% of participants agreed that they feel more prepared and confident in taking an accurate blood pressure measurement after the in-service
- 97% of participants agreed that the in-service information will help in their day-to-day work

The Program Details:

Created in partnership with the Maine Heart Center and MMC PHO, this free in-service focuses on:

- Updating providers on how to take accurate blood pressure measurements
- Discussing current blood pressure guidelines
- Briefly reviewing important blood pressure basics, including Maine’s blood pressure statistics and hypertension’s effects

Also included in the program at no charge:

- CME credits for physicians (DOs and MDs) and medical assistants. Nurses may submit non-physician certificates from the American Medical Association for credit.
- Blood Pressure Measurement Quick Guide for Screeners (cheat sheet on accurate technique)
- Copies of the latest blood pressure guidelines
- Access to free blood pressure and hypertension patient education tools
- A chance for a different clinician each month to win a free high-grade stethoscope!
